Operating equipment	Fire/operating accidents	Injury to members of public/burns/cuts/foreign bodies in eyes/smoke inhalation/ingestion	The Parish Council ensures the use of experienced Funeral Directors	L	Contractors or Funeral Directors and their Contractors will be liable for their own risk assessment to protect their employees and members of the public
Excavations/ground works	Falling/tripping injuries to back, sprains, strains, musculoskeletal injuries, cuts and bruises	Injury to members of the public and employees or Contractors of Funeral Directors	The Parish Council ensures the use of experienced Funeral Directors	L	Funeral Directors and their Contractors will be liable for their own Health & Safety measures
