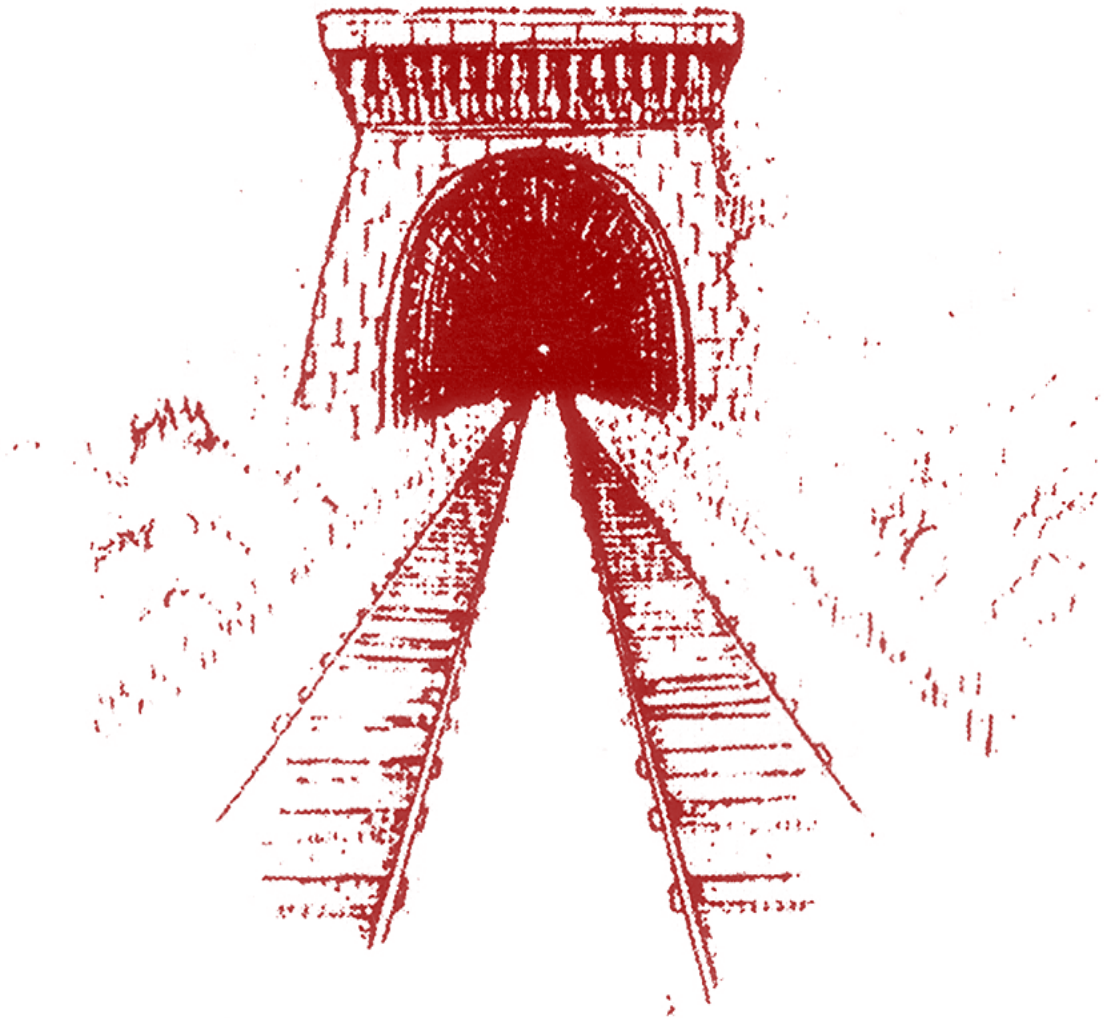

Amenities, Recreation and Leisure Facilities

1. Continue with tree planting where identified and appropriate
2. Publicise Village Clubs and Facilities and update details on the Kilsby Village website.
3. Implement arrangements for the sponsorship, improvement and maintenance of the A5 Roundabout.
4. Continue to lobby for Bus Services to be maintained and improved through to Rugby, Daventry and DIRFT.
5. Build a Petanque Court in the Recreation Ground.
6. Develop a regional history website.
7. Extend the Village Cemetery.
8. Improve Broadband connection for the Village investigating funding via DIRFT/BT and business occupiers at DIRFT as well as private initiatives.
9. Cut grass on all the verges from the village signs going into the Village.

Transport and Road Safety

1. Street lighting – continue with improvements by replacing obsolete equipment and develop a programme of modernizing remaining equipment. Replace the street light on the corner of Ashby Road by the junction, and investigate funding from the remaining 106 monies.
2. Complete the 106 funded highway works identified in phase one.
3. Undertake further 106 funded highway works from the remaining funds including: -
 - a. Ramp to Recreation Ground from Rugby Road
 - b. Upgrade pavement surfaces.
 - c. Construct traffic calming measures on Rugby Road at the junction with Kilsby Lane.
 - d. Flashing sign on Kilsby Lane before bend in Rugby Road.
 - e. 20 mph zones
 - f. Work with Northants County Council to ban HGV traffic through the Village and along the Ridge Road.
 - g. Remove grass outside the Chapel and lay a new tarmac surface.
 - h. Install ‘kissing gates’ on the footpath in Rugby Road.
 - i. Install a Pelican crossing on A5 near to the Village Hall
4. Continue with proactive campaign to prevent parking on grassed areas and obstructing footpaths.
5. Monitor cycle ways/footpath links through new applications at DIRFT
6. HGV parking to be removed from lay-bys on the edge of the Village through to DIRFT
7. Undertake pavement condition survey.
8. Look to improve footpath and cycle way links to DIRFT and Hillmorton
9. Purchase a hand push/towable grit and salt spreader
10. Install gateway features at all Village entrances.
11. Consider installing safety mirrors at the junction of Main Road and Rugby Road.

Parish Expansion

1. Prepare a Village Design Statement
2. Liase with Rugby Borough Council, Daventry District Council, Developers of DIRFT and the Rugby Radio Station Masts Site to
 - a. Develop Public Transport links
 - b. Protect and improve Footpaths/Cycle ways
 - c. Restrict HGV traffic movement through the Village from Hillmorton
3. Look to identify sites for affordable housing to provide housing for Kilsby Village residents.

Other.

1. Continue to promote Neighbourhood Watch
2. Progress discussions with Daventry District Council to identify a Conservation Area within the Village.
3. Investigate bringing mains gas into the Village.
4. Continue to liase to try to improve educational choices for children leaving the Primary School with access to Rugby and Warwickshire Schools.
5. Continue to lobby for the abatement of noise nuisance from Barby Sporting Club.
6. Consider ways of utilising the Community Payback Scheme.
7. Explore ways of establishing a Youth Councillor or representative.
8. Develop "Kilsby Calling" a parish wide email database for urgent and important communication.
9. Continue to support the provision of PCSO's for the Village
